Flowering Size Complex Seedlings

Complex Paphiopedilum seedlings, 3.25" pot size now available. Wholesale minimum order is one box of 25 plants. These are bench run selected plants from our most recent crosses. Selections will be five, ten, or twenty of each cross depending on numbers ordered. Complex Paphiopedilums begin to bud in September/October in the Pacific Northwest and bloom from October to April. Stock up now, the slipper season is just two months away.

Complex Paphiopedilums are shipped bare root or in pot. Shipping is at cost via FedEx.
